Groups gathering these supplies find themselves more engaged and interested when they have a personal involvement.

Campaigns to gather these items can be publicized through Facebook, Twitter, community newsletters, church bulletins, school newspapers, LinkedIn, personal letters, phone calls, and neighborhood flyers. Groups focus on a particular item each month, and everyone commits themselves to the small cost to obtain and donate the item. These are sent to the Malawi Project each month and they will be added to the next shipping container on the way to Malawi. You can also commit a small amount each month to sending the 40-foot shipping containers of supplies.
